We offer personalised support including one-on-one and couples counselling, and educational courses to empower you to create a meaningful, pleasurable, and rewarding sex life.

What we offer

Sexuality can be very personal and talking about difficulties can often bring up lots of emotions. With our service, you will be in a non-judgemental, confidential, and safe environment where you are supported to be yourself following injury, illness or disability.



Relationship and sexuality counselling:

A holistic approach to sexual wellbeing including personalised support to help you develop your confidence in exploring your sexual needs and abilities. All relationship styles are welcome, and people may attend individually or with their partner/s.



Sexuality clinic: Our specialised clinic has a holistic focus on all aspects of your sexual health and comprises a multi-disciplinary team of specialists including speech pathologists, occupational therapists, social workers, nurses and physiotherapists to help with a range of concerns.



Sexuality retreats: A safe space for couples and individuals to invest in relationships, build intimacy and communication skills.



Sexuality training and education

for clinicians: Training programs and workshops for clinicians to upskill, improve knowledge and understanding around a wide range of sexuality topics. Whether you are after one-hour sessions or full day workshops, our training is tailored to your needs.
